

BHB ANNUAL REPORT OCT. 2011 – OCT. 2012

HOUSE PROJECT:

- 15 houses (several with veranda), 4 stalls and 1 shed in the Srebrenica area

TRANSPORTS to Croatia and Bosnia:

- 3 heavy lorries with tools / dishwashers / seed / blankets / bed-linen / clothing / school-bags / mattresses / computers / floor covering / tableware sets
- 1 heavy lorry with clothing / new furniture / washing machines / television sets / bicycles
- 1 heavy lorry with clothing / seed / fridges / medical dressing material / sweets / biscuits / bed-linen / stoves / new furniture

OTHER AID

- 5 motor saws
- 2 small tractors + trailers from South Tyrol for farmers in the Srebrenica area
- 4 large four-wheel drive tractors from South Tyrol for farmers in the Srebrenica area
- 12 power connections, 1 power line, 1 water connection
- 22 sets of gardening tools (wheelbarrows, barrels, saws, axes, etc.)
- 500 food parcels personally distributed to families
- Financing of 6 cows, 65 sheep, 10 goats
- Financing of work on 25 hectares of arable land in 3 villages
- Financing of 12 grants for the school/university year 2011 / 2012
- Financing of monthly medical care for 120 people
- Financing of various therapies, operations, medication and dentures
- Financing of a place in a children's home for 1 boy
- Financing of repair to the miller's retaining wall
- Financing of the "daily bread" project for particularly needy families in Srebrenica and the surrounding area
- Financing of firewood for families in the Banja Luka and Srebrenica areas
- Financing of school transport for children from Srebrenica - excursion to the seaside
- Students and teachers from the Klessheim agricultural college, together with private donors from Mühlbach and the surrounding area financed and built houses in the Srebrenica area.
- Complete furnishings for 15 houses was donated by the firm of Prenneis.
- Financing and distribution of provisions and medicines (6,000 participants) at the 2012 Peace March to Srebrenica. The firm of Bahlsen donated biscuits.
- 10 village representatives received 10 first-aid kits and a one-day training course.
- Support for drug rehabilitation centres in the Banja Luka area

- 80 schoolbags were collected by schools a private individuals in Salzburg and distributed to children in Srebrenica and surrounding area.
- 25,000 bags of seed were collected by schoolchildren from South Tyrol and the Catholic Youth Organisation of Salzburg Diocese and distributed in Srebrenica and Banja Luka.
- Following a serious fire – supply of water and provisions for the village of Pirici
- Repairs to the Pirici/Srebrenica road by Rotary Club members
- Financing of the Srebrenica music school for 60 children aged 8-14. This project is supported by the Salzburg Rotary Club, Teamco Foundation, Mr. Müller, Mr. Weiper and Dr. Tutsch-Bauer.
5 teaching jobs were thus created.
- Various musical instruments were donated or purchased for the music school.
