BHB ANNUAL REPORT OCT. 2012 – OCT. 2013

HOUSE PROJECT:

- 9 houses and 3 stalls in the Srebrenica area

TRANSPORTS to Croatia and Bosnia:

- 2 lorries with clothing / tools / seed / blankets / bed-linen / computers / schoolbags / mattresses / 1 sewing machine
- 1 lorry with new furniture / biscuits / TVs / bicycles / 1 washing machine
- 3 lorries with clothing / seed / mattresses / medical dressings / sweets / bed-linen / stoves / new furniture / coffee / crockery

OTHER AID:

Financing for:

- 5 motor-saws
- 3 lawnmowers, 1 motocultivator with trailer
- 3 large 4-wheel-drive tractors from South Tyrol for farmers in the Srebrenica area
- 6 power connections, 6 water connections
- 11 sets of gardening tools (wheelbarrows, barrels, saws, axes, etc.)
- 400 food parcels for families in need
- 4 cows, 8 sheep, 10 goats, 1 horse
- work on 20 hectares arable land in 3 villages
- 12 grants for the school/academic year 2012 / 2013
- various therapies, operations, medication and dentures
- boarding costs for 4 children in Haus Emmaus
- firewood for families in the Banja Luca and Srebrenica areas
- furniture for 20 houses – donated by Prenneis company
- provisions for the drug rehabilitation centre in the Banja Luca area
- various instruments for the music school

Projects:

- "Daily bread" for particularly indigent families in Srebrenica and surrounding area
- 7 groups from the Mühlbach area, Salzburg and Kaprun financed and built houses in the Srebrenica area
- Distribution of provisions and medication at the 2013 Peace March (with 5500 participants) from Nezluk to Srebrenica
- Daily distribution of apples and bananas for 120 schoolchildren in Potocari
- Monthly medical care for 120 people in the Srebrenica area
- 20,000 bags of seed were collected by schoolchildren in South Tyrol and the Catholic Youth Organisation/ diocese of Salzburg and distributed in Srebrenica and Banja Luca

- Music school ((SUPERAR)) in Srebrenica – 90 children aged 8-14, 5 music teachers and 1 dance teacher. This project is sponsored by the Salzburg Altstadt Rotary Club and the Teamco Foundation, and by other foundations
- Various performances by the music school in Mostar, Sarajevo and at the Salzburg Festival
- 7 apprenticeships in bakery, agriculture, teaching and nursing
- At the end of August, the Blohappat/Zapp Zarap Circus gave its last guest performance in Srebrenica and – as in previous years – entertained 250 children and their parents. BhB – South Tyrol provided a concert with Deborah Rosenkranz for young people in Srebrenica

CREDITS:

In 2012/2013 we granted small credits to the value of € 1,800.

"Sing over your own shadow"

This was a year of music. The first official performances by our ((SUPERAR)) children were given at the United World College in Mostar, a music school in Sarajevo, and the Salzburg Festival, where they joined with El Sistema and 300 more ((SUPERAR)) children from Romania, Slovakia, Liechtenstein and Austria in a fantastic concert in Hangar 7. It was a huge success, beyond all our wildest hopes! The music school is becoming more ambitious; the children are gaining self-confidence and developing into really good singers and instrumentalists. It has become a place of hope and trust, and our children and their teachers have learned to leap over their own shadow, and sing...

Some day, Srebrenica should be not only associated with genocide – but seen as a place where the BEST and happiest music school in Bosnia has found a home. The first seeds have been sown. We will progress step by step – life waits for no one...
