BhB ANNUAL REPORT OCT. 2013 – OCT. 2014

HOUSE PROJECT:

- 8 houses, 3 stalls and 5 verandas in the Srebrenica area; 5 of these houses were erected by 5 groups from Austria, Liechtenstein and Germany.

TRANSPORTS to Croatia and Bosnia:

- 1 lorry with clothing / seed / 1 washing machine / bed-linen / shoes / school bags / mattresses / furniture
- 1 lorry with 40 pallets of protective masks from the Austrian Federal Armed Forces
- 1 lorry with flour / jam / clothing / bicycles / baby food
- 1 lorry with tiles / parquet flooring / furniture / clothing / baby food
- 1 lorry with clothing / 2500 tins of coffee / starter sets for houses
- 1 lorry with 80 filing cabinets
- 1 lorry with 1 piano / coffee / bicycles / furniture / TVs / school bags / clothing
- 1 lorry with clothing / tools / mattresses / blankets / sanitary products / bed-linen
- 3 lorries with new sanitary products
- 3 lorries with clothing / water / tools / baby food / furniture / provisions / sanitary products / crockery / blankets (collected privately for victims of flooding)

FURTHER AID:

Financing of:

- 5 motor saws
- 2 sickle mowers
- 1 motor cultivator with trailer
- 1 4-wheel-drive tractor for a family in the Srebrenica area
- 8 power connections, 8 water connection
- 1 power line for the whole village of Kutuzero (part-financed)
- 22 sets of gardening tools (wheelbarrows, barrels, saws, axes, etc.)
- 1,000 pairs of rubber boots, 30 wheelbarrows, 100 spades, 100 pickaxes
- 300 food parcels for families in need
- 3 cows, 8 sheep, 5 goats, 10 beehives
- Work for 20 hectares arable land in 3 villages
- 4 toilets
- 2 surfaced roads to Grabosko and Slatina (destroyed in flooding)
- 1 suspension bridge in Konjevic Polje (destroyed in flooding)
- Renovation of 2 greenhouses and 2 apartments

- 11 grants for the school/academic year 2013/2014
- Various therapies, operations, medical supplies and dentures
- Boarding costs for 4 children in Haus Emmaus
- Firewood for families in the Banja Luka and Srebrenica area
- Furniture for 20 houses
- 1 stone house for Mama Petra (BhB wooden house burned down)
- Monthly food distribution for 11 families

Projects:

- "Daily bread" for particularly needy families in Srebrenica and surrounding area
- 5 groups from Liechtenstein, Salzburg, Lower Austria, Vienna and Germany financed houses and erected houses in the Srebrenica area
- Distribution of provisions and medical supplies for 5,500 participants in the Peace March from Nezluk to Srebrenica on 9-11 July 2014
- Daily distribution of apples and bananas for 120 children in the school in Potocari
- Monthly medical care for 120 people in the Srebrenica area
- 20,000 seed packets collected by schoolchildren in South Tyrol and the Catholic Youth Group in the diocese of Salzburg, and distributed in Srebrenica and Banja Luka
- 2 trainee places for baking, education and nursing
- The song "Love People" composed by Ismar Poric (director of the music school) after the flooding catastrophe, recorded with our ((Superar)) children and well-known singers from Bosnia, Croatia, Serbia and Montenegro and publicly presented. Proceeds from the sale of CDs goes to a benefit fund for music schools in Maglaj und Doboje. **Youtube: Superar Bosnia**
- In August a drumming workshop was held in Srebrenica for more than 150 children from Austria, Romania, Slovakia and Bosnia. **Youtube: Superar Summercamp 2014**
- Music school ((SUPERAR)) in Srebrenica – currently 120 children aged 8-14
In September 2014, our music school was installed in a house of its own – the "Haus der guten Töne"; it will be open for the music school, guests and other events.
- 27/28 September 2014, BhB co-organised the EU Conference in Srebrenica (120 participants)
- Performances by the ((Superar)) children in Srebrenica, Switzerland and Sarajevo
