HOUSE PROJECTS/Srebrenica and surrounding area

24 houses with toilets and water supply were built by 12 construction groups from Austria, Germany and Liechtenstein (one of these groups comprised members from 17 different countries).

- 2.500 small bags of seed from children from the Salzburg Catholic Youth Group were distributed in Srebrenica und Banja Luca
