HOUSE PROJECTS/Srebrenica and surrounding area

24 houses with toilets and water supply, and 3 stalls were built by 11 construction groups from Austria, Germany and Liechtenstein (5 of these groups from the HILTI company).

Construction groups: HILTI, Klessheim Agricultural College, Intarconnect/Rotary, Working Angels, Politisch.Neu.Denken/Figlhaus Vienna

- Distribution of food and medical supplies for The Red Cross at the Peace March from Nezluk to Srebrenica, 9 – 11 July 2018 (5,000 participants)
- Distribution of 2,200 small bags of seed sent by children from the Catholic Youth Group of the Salzburg Archdiocese
- Raspberry plantation in Pirici – jobs for 2 local families and 10 further people during the season

MUSIC SCHOOL SREBRENICA – house of good tones

(1 September 2017 – 1 September 2018)

With more than 350 children, over 20 concerts and a large number of visits, this was a very successful school year. The doors of our „Haus der guten Töne“ were again open to all who take an interest in our work.

- 2018 Srebrenica Music Camp

The most important event in this school year was the 2018 Srebrenica Music Camp. 150 children from Croatia, Serbia and Bosnia and Herzegovina took part. The Camp was held in Srebrenica from 29 July until 4 August, with the aim of offering the children, through music, access to culture and the arts, encouraging intercultural dialogue, mutual understanding and collaboration. The participants had the opportunity of meeting major international artists and of working with them. A special guest of honour was Gerald Wirth, choirmaster of the Vienna Boys' Choir; he coached our children at the summer camp and conducted the final concert.

The 2018 Srebrenica Music Camp culminated in a concert with all performers which will remain in the memory for a long time. All the media in the country and beyond carried reports on this event.

For legal reasons, our music school now bears the name “Haus der guten Töne”; ((Superar)) is **no longer** a part of the name.



Once again, we look back on a year filled with joy and success – but sadly, we also experienced profound sorrow and anxiety. The political situation in Bosnia is worsening and threatening to escalate, so that the entire population feels increasingly unsettled. However, many events have contributed to making this year a very special one for us.

- Hasan Nuhanovic's life story – based on his book *The Last Refuge* – was staged by director Peter Arp (in collaboration with BhB) as a drama entitled *Srebrenica*, in the Salzburg Schauspielhaus. The 17 performances were widely acclaimed, and we are proud to say that the play has been nominated for the important Nestroy Theatre Prize, which is awarded at the end of the year. Peter Arp says: „I'm delighted at the nomination. First, because it is a recognition of this project, into which we put some eighteen months of work, from the initial idea to the performance. Second, and more important, it is a recognition of the subject and its adaptation. The entire team was with me at the scene in Srebrenica; they met Hasan Nuhanovic and drew long-lasting inspiration from him and his harrowing story. Basically, it concerns the 1995 genocide, but at the same time it is a tribute to all those who are forced to flee from violence and terrorism. It is the dramatised examination of the devastation inflicted by war, wherever it may be in the world, and what it does to people.“ The play was filmed and is available on YouTube. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=zYc9JSmx6lA>
- Doraja Eberle received the Humanum fundatio Lifetime Achievement Award from the Idriz Jakupovic Foundation.
- August saw a fantastic summer camp, organised by our music school, the „Haus der guten Töne“ in Srebrenica – a lighthouse project for the whole country. Music unites people, and in recent years we have experienced at first hand just how much people can find new ways of coming together through the possibilities it offers.
